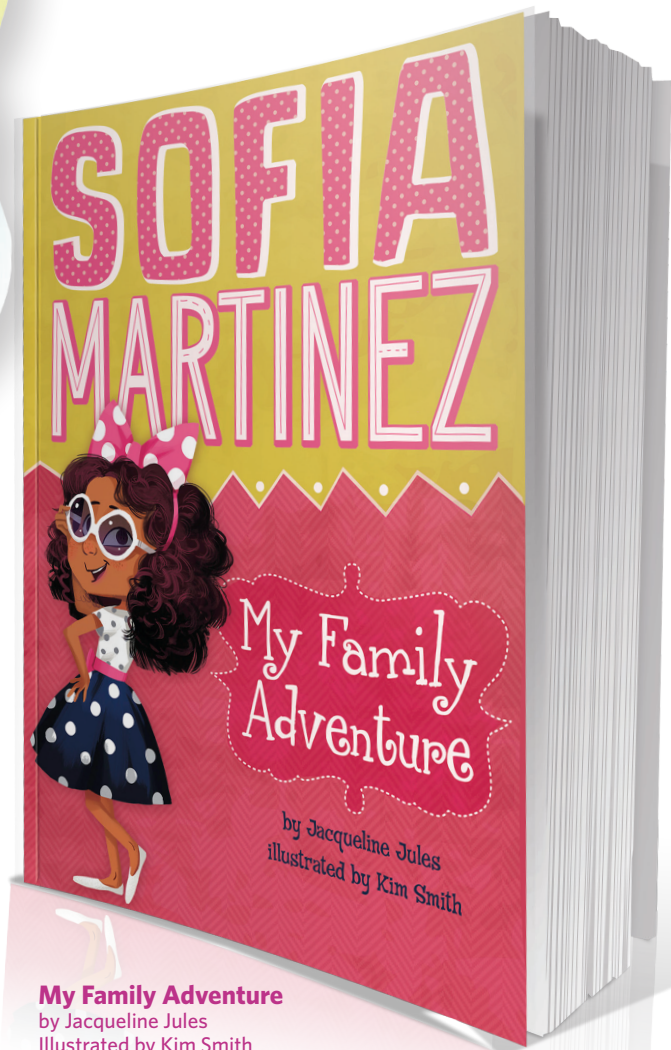

Abuela couldn't stop smiling.

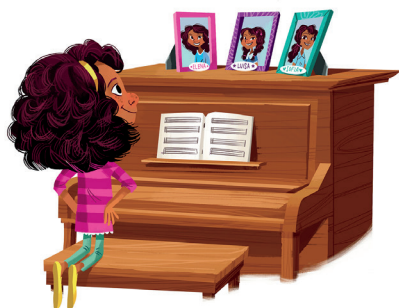
"**Niña hermosa.**"
